HI-POINT POLICY 2019

Darwin Dressage Club (DDC) on behalf of the Australian Stock Horse Society (ASHS) will select a; Hi-Point ASH Horse.

The Hi-Point award is open to all competition eligible Australian Stock Horses – as per the ASHS online stud book. Horses must be registered with ASH and owner be a financial member for the horse registration to be valid.

Horses eligibility will be verified with ASHS on completion of the eligible events.

Eligible Events

Eligible events to ASHS Hi-Points gain points are:

- Sunday 12 May 2019
- Sunday 23 June 2019
- Saturday 21 to Sunday 22 September 2019

Though your chances to win the Hi-Point Award will increase if competing in each event, it is not compulsory to.

Both Closed Restricted and Official Competitive competitions are eligible to gain ASHS Hi-Points. For example:

- Preliminary
- Novice
- Elementary
- Medium
- Advanced

Please note Preparatory and FEI competitions are excluded from gaining ASHS Hi-Points.

Points will be taken from the highest 2 placings in the eligible competitions from either Closed Restricted or Official Competitive competitions.

Points for placings will be awarded as per the ASHS point system for dressage, as per below:

Dressage level	Points 1 st	Points 2 nd	Points 3 rd	Points 4 th	Points 5 th
DP- Preliminary	7	5	2	1	0
DN-Novice	7	5	2	1	0
DE- Elementary	10	7	5	2	1
DE-Medium	15	10	7	5	2
DA -Advanced	20	15	10	7	5

Points will be tallied, and the Hi-Point ASH will be announced at the DDC end of year presentation. This event sponsored by ASHS NT who have donated a rug.

Points are awarded to the horse rider combination- not solely the rider. Riders competing on different horses will accumulate points per horse, not as an aggregate across all horses.

In event of a tie, the horse rider combination with the highest percentage in the highest-level test will be the winner.
