High Points Policy 2019



Darwin Dressage Club will select a

- High Point Senior Rider and a
- High point Junior Rider

annually, based upon the DDC High points policy.

The purpose of this policy is to:

- Create transparency in selection of award recipients
- Encourage participation
- Promote healthy competition
- Desire to train and improve
- Have Fun
- Be inclusive

Points will be awarded to current financial members competing in Darwin Dressage Club closed restricted competitions and Official Competitive competitions, per horse and rider combination.

Points are calculated over two tests so if a member rides 3 tests, for example 2 x OC & 1 X CR then the two highest scoring tests will be used to calculate the points for the leader board.

In the event that more than one judge is scoring a test the points will be calculated on the combined percentages.

Points will be allocated when the test score Equals or exceeds:

1. Preparatory 65%

65% to 66.999 1 Point

67% to 68.999 2 Points

69% to 70.999 3 Points

71% and over 4 points

2. Preliminary 63%

63% to 64.999 1 Point

65% to 66.999 2 Points

67% to 68.999 3 Points

69% and over 4 points

3. Novice 61%

61% to 62.999 1 Point

63% to 64.999 2 Points

65% to 66.999 3 Points

67% and over 4 points

4. Elementary 60%

60% to 61.999 1 Point

62% to 63.999 2 Points

64% to 65.999 3 Points

66% and over 4 points

5. Medium and above 58%

58% to 59.999 1 Point

60% to 61.999 2 Points

62% to 63.999 3 Points

64% and over 4 points

These points will be calculated after each competition and a Leader board table will be emailed and loaded on to social media for all members to follow.

In the event of a tie between members the Junior and senior member with the highest average collective score will determine the winner.

Winners will be presented with a High Points embroidered rug at the Darwin Dressage Club end of year annual celebrations.
