OFF THE TRACK THOROUGHBRED - TRNT

HI-POINT POLICY 2023

Darwin Dressage Club (DDC) on behalf of Thoroughbred Racing Northern Territory will be offering a Hi-Point Award to the

1. OTT combination who achieves the highest number of points *and*
2. OTT runner-up combination who achieves the second highest number of points

over eligible competitions throughout the 2023 competition season.

The aim of this award is to

1. Encourage active participation of thoroughbred horses in the sport of Dressage after completion of their racing career.

To be eligible to receive points the following conditions apply.

Eligible Combinations

1. Riders must be a DDC current financial member
2. Thoroughbred horses must be registered with TRNT

(Horses' eligibility will be verified with TRNT on close of entry for eligible events.)

Eligible Events

Points may be earned at the following DDC ran events for the 2023 season

1. 22/1 DDC Australia Day Competition
2. 2/4 DDC April Competition No 1
3. 30/4 DDC April Competition No 2
4. 21/5 DDC May Competition
5. 11/6 DDC June Competition
6. 20/8 DDC Dressage Championships

Points may be earned competing in

1. Closed Restricted competitions
2. Official Competitive competitions

Points may be earned across the following levels

1. Preparatory
2. Preliminary
3. Novice
4. Elementary
5. Medium

Points will be allocated for the following placings:

1st place 7 points

2nd place 6 points

3rd place 5 points

4th place 4 points

5th place 3 points

6th place 2 point

Participation 1 point

Example of how points are calculated.

8 combinations compete in Preliminary 1.2

3 combinations are TRNT

Results of the competition are as follows:

1 st	Non TRNT	
2 nd	TRNT	6 points
3 rd	Non TRNT	
4 th	Non TRNT	
5 th	TRNT	3 points
6 th	Non TRNT	
7 th	Non TRNT	
8 th	TRNT	1 participation point

Presentations

The Hi-Point and runner up OTT combinations will be announced at the DDC end of year awards presentation night.

In the event of a tie the horse and rider combination with the highest percentage in the highest-level test will be the winner.

As this event is kindly sponsored by TRNT, they will be donating a Custom halter with engraving and sash to the Hi point winners across the five levels of competition.

TRNT will also be donating a prize and ribbon to the OTT runner up combinations across the five levels of competition.
